

KEY OBJECTIVE & STRATEGIC PLAN

Pillar 1: Increase ID Pharmacist Participation with LSHP

- Offer Accredited CE for ID Pharmacists across the state
- Develop and Antimicrobial Stewardship “roadshow” to engage students and other pharmacists in aligned efforts statewide
- Encourage ID focused exposure for trainees (students, residents, fellows)

Pillar 2: Develop a culture of state-wide sharing and access to antimicrobial stewardship resources

- Statewide mapping of ID PharmD and MD/ASP programs by parish (inpatient & outpatient)
- Statewide ID/ASP directory
- Quarterly IDChats (facilitated on virtual platform to engage)

Pillar 3: Assuring Equity in Antimicrobial Stewardship & Infectious Diseases Resources for Patient Education statewide

- Determine what equity needs exist in ASP resourcing statewide
- Engage ID Residents in DEI project focused on patient engagement for common ID presentation (e.g.: doctor discussion guide, patient navigation one pager, etc.)
